

1. A preliminary report, within the first three (3) months
2. A Final Report, which shall be delivered to the President of the Republic, no later than six (6) months from the date of installation of the Committee.

In case it is deemed necessary to achieve the objectives for which it was created, the Committee may request the Republic of Panama to extend the term of delivery of the Final Report for up to an additional 2 months.

Article 4. The Camire shall have the power to regulate its own affairs and to establish the parameters and procedures for the conduct of its sessions, the adoption of its conclusions and any other matters that it deems necessary.

The Republic of Panama shall provide the support personnel required by the Committee.

Article 5. The Committee may, when it deems it appropriate, create sub-committees to facilitate the study of specific topics and / or external inputs necessary to achieve the objectives for which it was created.

Article 6. The members of the Cornite will not receive compensation for their time and services. However, all expenses incurred by members shall be covered by the Government of the Republic of Panama

Article 7. The inputs, deliberations and other information and documents generated by the Committee shall be kept confidential until the Committee presents its conclusions to the President of the Republic. These conclusions are property and use for the Republic of Panama, who may share them with the rest of the world as recommendations of best practices for the international community.

Public communications will be the exclusive responsibility of the Government of the Republic of Panama.

Article 8. This Executive Decree shall take effect from the date of its promulgation.
